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How YOUR Gift Dollars Make a Difference

Caring Solutions receives a designated amount of funding specific to the unique needs of each of the individuals with developmental disabilities approved to receive services through the Department of Mental Health. (averaging 100 served annually).

Still, for most there is a significant shortfall in many areas deemed vital - some even mandatory - for Caring Solutions to provide and not funded by any other source then charitable financial support.

When you give, your donation is helping to meet the shortfall and the following special needs:

START-UP EXPENSES to begin providing services for an individual averages \$2-\$3,000

TRAINING is ongoing for our employees and Caring Solutions excels at providing life-saving training and other critical curriculum and certification. Much of the expenses are not reimbursed—even that which is required. Paying the employees for hours in training plus the costs associated with the training averages \$1,200 monthly

NURSING STAFF are absolutely essential with the high needs of the individuals served, but costs are only reimbursed at approximately 45% for an average deficit of **\$10,000 monthly**

MOVING EXPENSES for incoming and existing clients averages **\$1,000** monthly

REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE NEEDS in the homes sites plus the Valentine Place therapeutic respite home averages **\$900 monthly**

MEDICAL, DENTAL AND VISION basic costs are often only partially covered and specialty services such as sedation for dental services are often required but not funded and can cost \$900-\$1,300. Vision needs and glasses expense averages \$90-\$300

RENT/UTILITIES/FOOD/PERSONAL NECESSITIES can only be partially covered for those who qualify for monthly Supplemental Security Income which is only \$800-\$1,000 but several do not even receive this SSI funding

NEW AND INNOVATIVE PROGRAMS such as expansion of crisis and respite services are totally dependent on gift dollars!
